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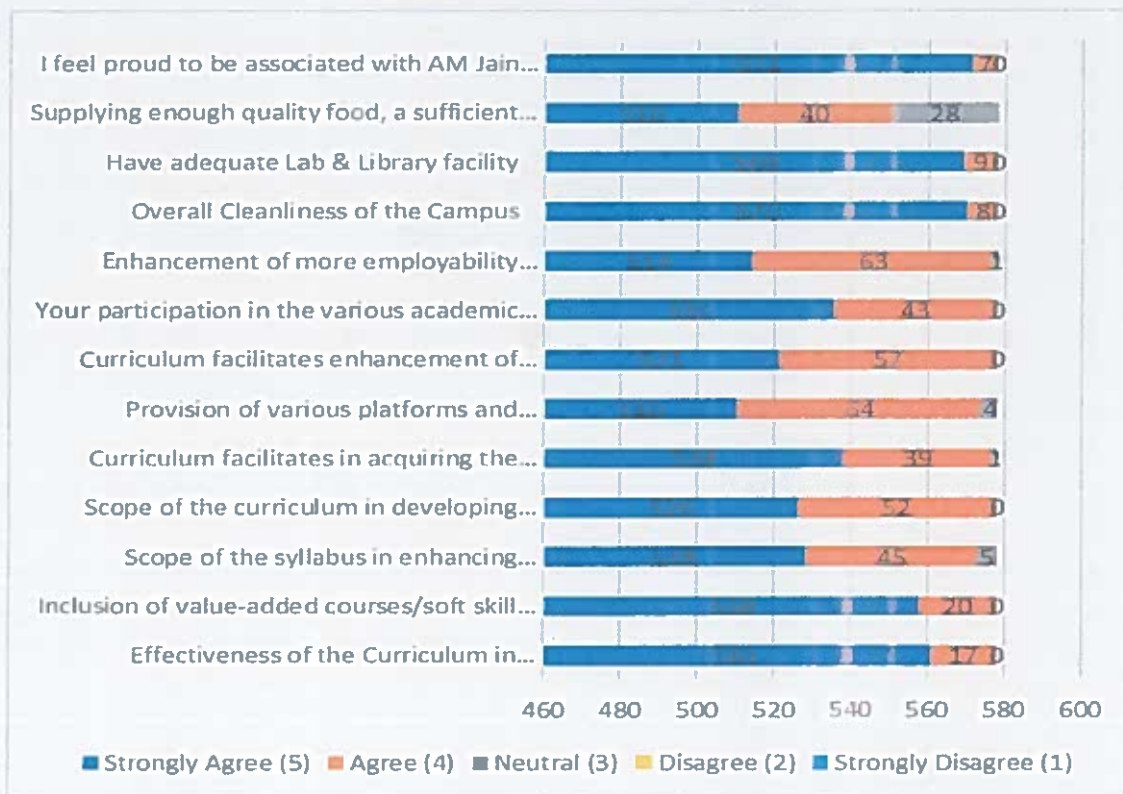

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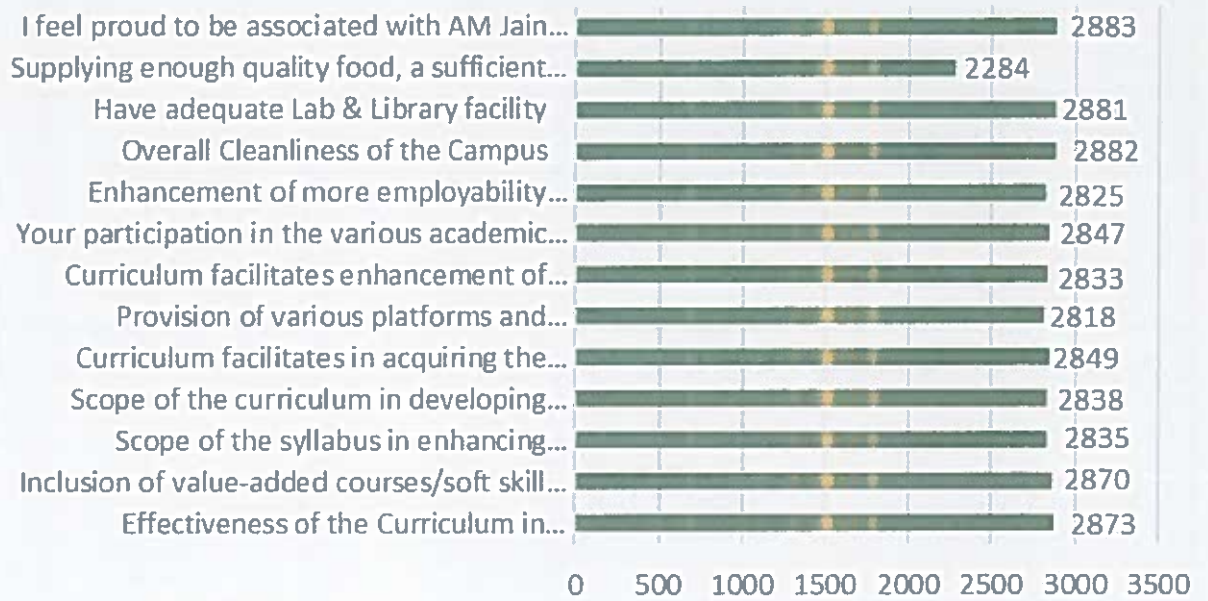

### TOTAL WEIGHTAGE



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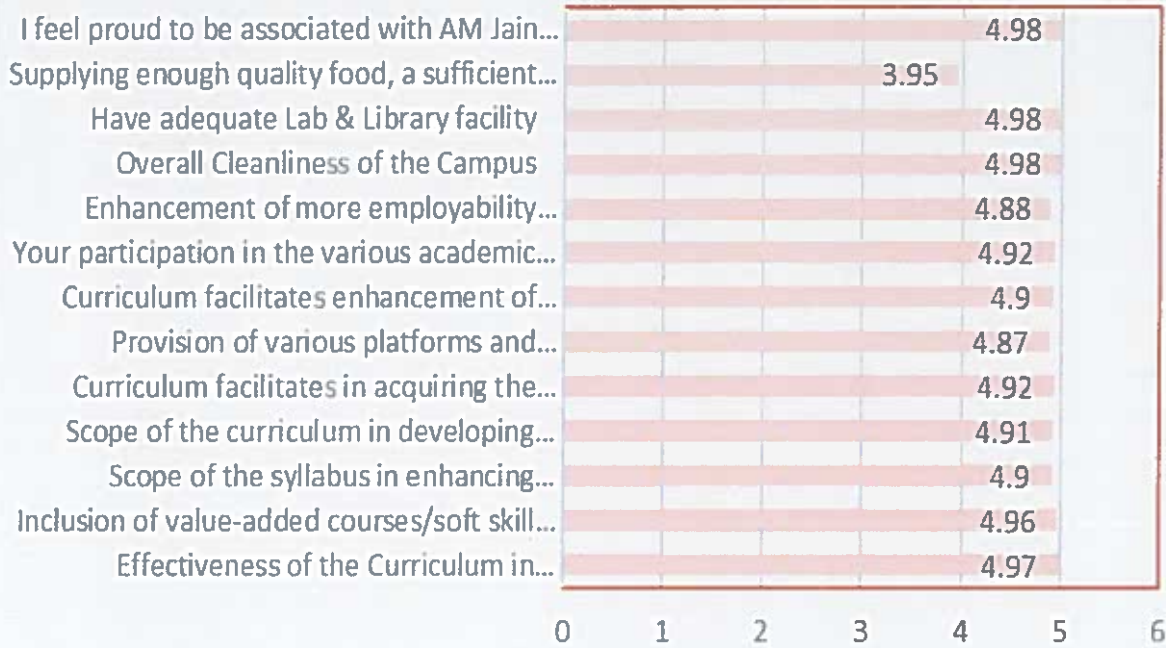

#### **\*\*Curriculum and Academic Experience: \*\***

1. Effectiveness of the Curriculum in developing analytical and problem-solving skills - A significant percentage of respondents (72% Strongly Agree, 28% Agree) acknowledge the effectiveness of the curriculum in developing analytical and problem-solving skills. 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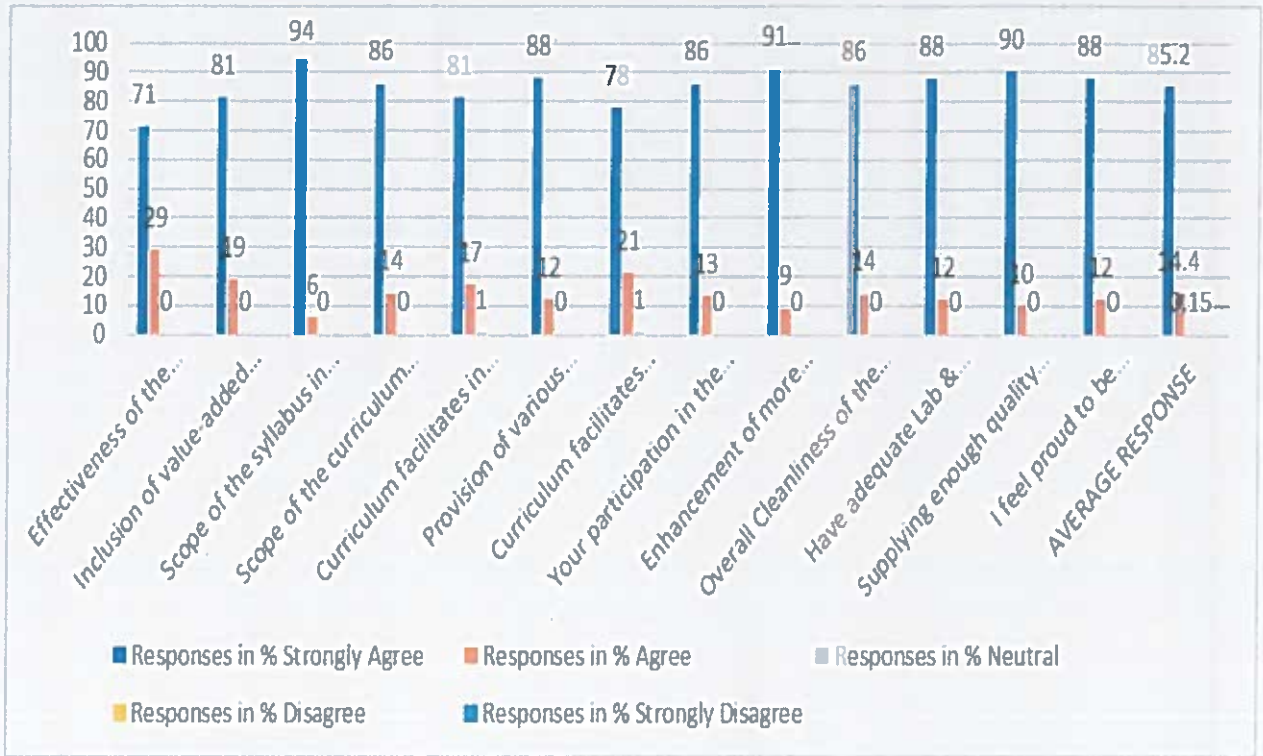
