6000 STUDENTS ATTEMPT WORLD RECORD



A.M. Jain College, a leading educational institution in Chennai, attempted a historic world record today, as they celebrate their 122nd Founder's Day. In a grand display of unity and literary appreciation, over 6,000 students from the college came together to read a selected collection of poems within 15 minutes, aiming to secure a place in the Virtue Book of World Records. The event also had a mosaic formation of AMJ, by the college students. The event featured the collective reading of eight poems, chosen for their inspirational and timeless themes.

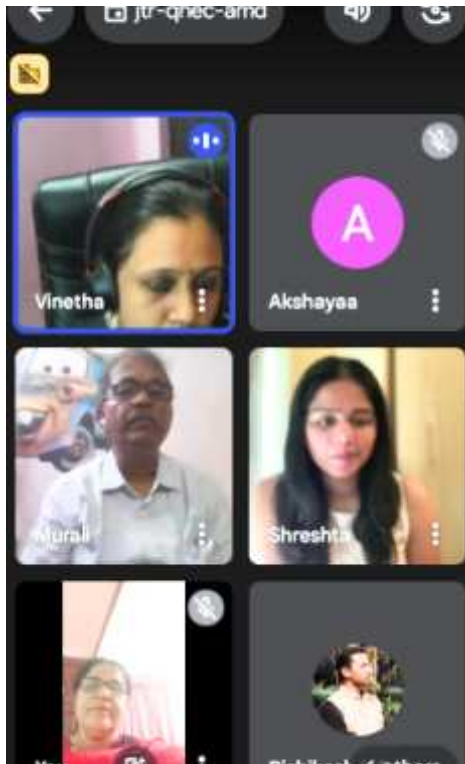
DRUG AWARENESS PROGRAMME

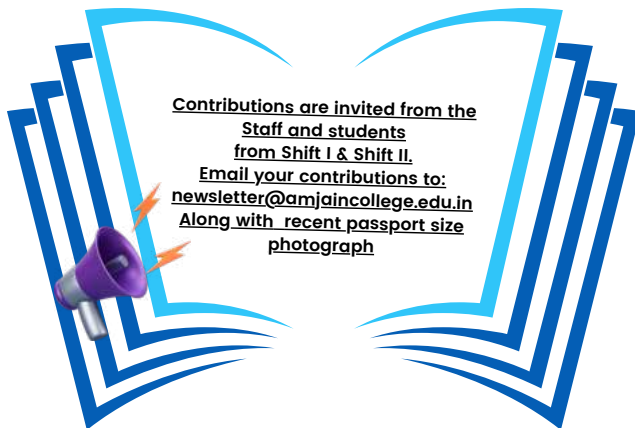
