JOY OF GIVING



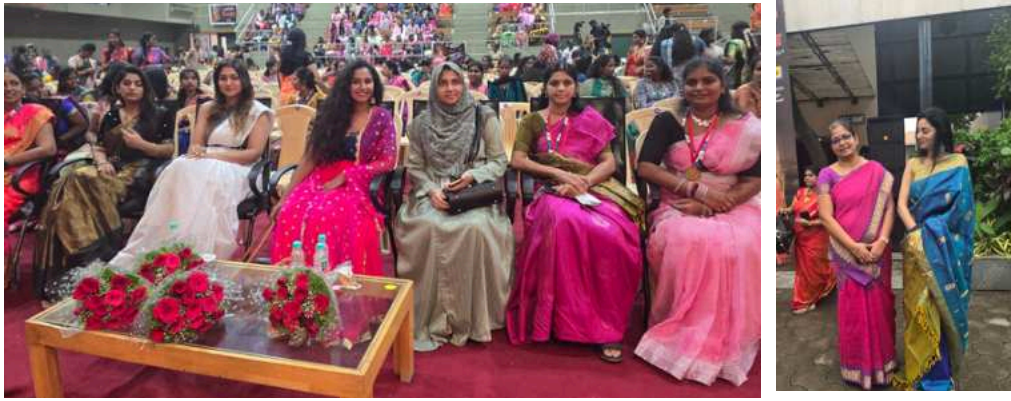

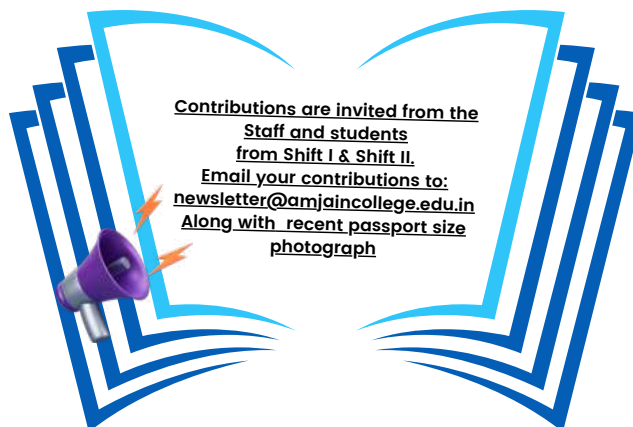
